



KENT MUSEUM OF THE MOVING IMAGE

A sojourn by the seaside with a special tour of the museum plus a delicious gourmet tea, sourced from local Kent suppliers.

Kent MOMI celebrates 350 years of the moving and projected image. The not-for-profit museum explores the deep history of the moving image — from the days of candle-lit magic lantern performances and hand-painted slides through Victorian visual experimentation to the advent and heyday of the cinema.

In August there will be four special exhibitions on show. **The Margaret Amaral Gallery** traces the History of Cinema and of Representation itself. **The Terence Marsh Gallery** and adjoining rooms display Passport to Ealing: The Films and Their Posters, 1938-1958. **The Front Room** uses original artefacts to tell the story of The Royal Polytechnic Institution and Multi-Media Victorian London. In **Susan's Room:** Vintage Vinten is a tribute to William Vinten, one of the major pioneers of British cinema.

Founders and Curators David Francis OBE and Dr. Joss Marsh will guide us through this extraordinary collection of moving and projected image artefacts. The museum is normally closed to the public on Wednesdays, but is opening specially for our visit.

The gourmet tea will include varieties of bread, extra special Kentish cheeses with home-made pickles and the possibility of rhubarb grown in the garden of the museum.

The museum is situated at 41 Stanhope Road, Deal, Kent CT14 6AD in the heart of the picturesque Kent seaside town, two minutes' walk from Deal Railway Station and Deal Pier and Seafront. Details of travel arrangements by train or bus and parking for cars will be supplied.
